## Albania

### Radio Televizioni Shqiptar

Radio Televizioni Shqiptar (English: Albanian Radio and Television; mostly called RTSH) is the national public broadcasting company of Albania. All domestic broadcasting on mediumwave has been discontinued.

## Andorra

### Ràdio i Televisió d'Andorra

RTVA, is the public and commercial broadcaster in the Principality of Andorra. There is no broadcasting on mediumwave.

## Austria

### Österreichischer Rundfunk

Österreichischer Rundfunk (ORF - Austrian Broadcasting Corporation) is Austria's largest media provider, operating four national television and twelve radio channels, as well as a comprehensive range of websites.

### Museumsradio AM 1476

Museumsradio AM 1476 is the brainchild of Reinhard Pirnbacher, who has moderated the "Pirnis Plattenkiste" programme at Radio Salzburg for over 14 years. His museum broadcasting station airs old German and international record productions. Pirnbacher draws on a collection of over 100,000 records.

## Azores

### RTP Antena 1 Açores

RTP, formally Rádio e Televisão de Portugal, is the public service broadcasting organisation of Portugal. RTP Antena 1 Açores is a regional station for the Azores. It had most recently operated on 828 kHz but that is currently believed to be off-air.

## Belarus

### Belteleradio

The National State TV and Radio Company of the Republic of Belarus), known as Belteleradiocompany or simply Belteleradio, is the state radio and television broadcasting service in Belarus. There is no longer any domestic broadcasting on mediumwave (or longwave and shortwave).

## Belgium

### RTBF / VRT / BRFB

Vlaamse Radio en Televisieomroep (VRT), Radio-Télévision Belge de la Communauté Française (RTBF) and Belgisches Rundfunk und Fernsehzentrum der Deutschsprachigen Gemeinschaft (BRF) are the Dutch, French and German language broadcasting networks in Belgium. There is no longer any domestic broadcasting on mediumwave.

## Bosnia and Herzegovina

### Radio-Televizija Bosne i Hercegovine (BHRT) / Radio-Televizija Federacije Bosne i Hercegovine (RTV FBiH) / Radio Televizija Republike Srpske (RTRS)

BHRT, RTV FBiH and RTRS are the Bosnian, Croatian and Serbian language broadcasting networks in Bosnia and Herzegovina. There is no domestic broadcasting on mediumwave from these organisations.

### Radio 1503

Radio 1503 is the only radio station in Bosnia and Herzegovina that is still broadcasting on mediumwave. The schedule includes relays of BHR-1 and Radio FBiH at certain times and also carries the RFE/RL Bosnian Service at 0700-0800, 1400-1430, 1700-1730, 2100-2200 and 2300-0000 as per the [RFE/RL website](#) (with times adjusted to UTC)

## Bulgaria

### Bulgarian National Radio

Bulgarian National Radio is Bulgaria's national radio broadcasting organisation. It operates two national and nine regional channels, as well as an international service.

### BNR-1, Horizont

Horizont is BNR's most listened-to channel, with round-the-clock news, comment, and music. It can be heard throughout Bulgaria on mediumwave 576 kHz.

## Croatia

### Hrvatska Radiotelevizija

Hrvatska Radiotelevizija (HRT) is a Croatian public broadcasting company. It operates several radio and television channels, over a domestic transmitter network as well as satellite. HRT is divided into three joint companies - Croatian Radio (Hrvatski Radio), Croatian Television (Hrvatska Televizija) and Music Production (Glazbena Proizvodnja). Croatian Radio operates three national stations, several regional branches and an international service. All domestic broadcasting on mediumwave has been discontinued.

# Cyprus

## Cyprus Broadcasting Corporation

Cyprus Broadcasting Corporation is the public broadcasting service of Cyprus. CyBC currently operates two channels on mediumwave. The First Channel, known as RIK Proto, features news, current affairs, educational and cultural programmes on FM and MW 963 kHz. It has programming for children and young adults on history and classical, modern and traditional music. The Third Channel, known as RIK Triton, is primarily an entertainment and information channel.

## International broadcasting from Cyprus

### Encompass East Mediterranean Relay Station

The Encompass East Mediterranean Relay Station used to exclusively relay BBC World Service programmes until they were discontinued on 26 January 2023 (the last remaining service had been BBC Arabic to North Africa and the Middle East on 639 and 720 kHz). Since then Encompass has kept the transmitters on standby for use as required and at the current time there are broadcasts from BBC Arabic, Monte Carlo Doualiya and Al Arabiya FM being aired.

# Czech Republic

## Český rozhlas

Český rozhlas (ČRo) is the public radio broadcaster of the Czech Republic operating continuously since 1923. It is the oldest radio broadcaster in continental Europe and the second oldest in Europe after the BBC. Český Rozhlas was established in 1992 by the Czech Radio Act, which sets out the framework for its operation and financing. It acts as the successor to the previous state-owned Czechoslovak Radio which ceased to exist by 1992. All ČRo services on longwave and mediumwave were discontinued on 31 December 2021.

## Country Radio

Country Radio is the first music station that specialises exclusively in country music genres. It is one of the most successful regional radios on the Czech market.

## Radio Impuls

Radio Impuls is a private radio station operating in the Czech Republic. It was formed in 1999, when it replaced the nationwide radio station Alfa Radio, which did not defend its license. Radio Impuls is the most listened radio station in the Czech Republic. Since September 2014, an additional service called Český Impuls has been broadcast on 981 kHz specialising in Czech songs mostly from the 60s to the 80s.

## DR

DR, officially the Danish Broadcasting Corporation in English, is a Danish public-service radio and television broadcasting company. Founded in 1925 as a public-service organisation, it is Denmark's oldest and largest electronic media enterprise. There is no longer any broadcasting from DR on mediumwave.

## Radio208

Radio208 plays progressive classic rock from 1964-1984 with no studio hosts.

# Estonia

## Eesti Rahvusringhääling (ERR)

Eesti Rahvusringhääling (ERR) - Estonian Public Broadcasting - is a publicly funded and owned radio and television organisation created in Estonia on 1 June 2007 to take over the functions of the formerly separate Eesti Raadio (ER) (Estonian Radio) and Eesti Televisioon (ETV) (Estonian Television), under the terms of the Estonian National Broadcasting Act. There is no domestic broadcasting on mediumwave or shortwave.

### International broadcasting from Estonia

## Radio Eli

The mediumwave transmitter on 1035 kHz is owned by Tartu Pereraadio for broadcasts to Russia. It is used primarily by Eli Family Radio, operating under the name of Radio Eli, and includes a relay of TWR.

TWR programmes are broadcast Monday-Friday 1900-2005 and 2015-2120 UTC, except for Belarusian at 1915-1930 and 2030-2045 UTC on Wednesdays. Radio Eli sometimes makes its own announcements or plays songs between TWR programmes. The TWR interval signal may also be played between some programmes, but not always. (thanks to Alex Miatlikov for his observations, 8 October 2024)

# Faroe Islands

## Kringvarp Føroya Útvarpid

Kringvarp Føroya is the national broadcasting company of the Faroe Islands. It was founded on 1 January 2005 after a merging of the national Faroese radio (Útvarp Føroya) and the national Faroese Television (Sjónvarp Føroya).

## Yleisradio Oy

Yleisradio Oy (lit. 'Public Radio, Ltd'), abbreviated as Yle and translated to English as the Finnish Broadcasting Company, is Finland's national public broadcasting company. There is no longer any broadcasting on mediumwave by Yle.

## Scandinavian Weekend Radio

Scandinavian Weekend Radio (SWR) is a radio station in Virrat, Finland, established in 2000. It was the first private radio station on MW/SW in Finland. It is run by volunteers of which many are radio amateurs, DXers and former pirate radio operators. SWR broadcasts for 24 hours from 0000 local time on the first Saturday of the month (except for January, May and September). Further information can be found at <http://www.swradio.net/>

## Alfa Media Group Oy

The Finnish Transport and Communications Agency Traficom has granted Alfa Media Group Oy a software license for the more marginal AM radio operation in Finland on the medium wave frequency in Pori. In September, the agency also granted licenses for FM radio operations to those locations where there were enough frequencies for all applicants. Now the Government has made the decisions regarding the frequencies that had several applicants. Traficom has granted Alfa Media Group Oy a license for the AM radio frequency Pori 963 kHz, which was applied for in the radio round last summer. There are hardly any AM broadcasts in Finland these days, and in recent years there has been only one AM radio station in Tampere in long-term operation. (Kari Kallio - WOR IOG, 8 November 2024)

# France

## Radio France

Radio France is the French national public radio broadcaster. The Radio France group is 100% owned by the French State. Nearly 80% of Radio France's funding comes from Television licence, the remaining 20% comes from own resources, mainly from advertising and diversification activities developed by Radio France. All domestic broadcasting from Radio France has been discontinued on mediumwave.

## Bretagne 5

Bretagne 5 is a private radio station located in Brittany. It was originally called Littoral AM but was relaunched in June 2015 as the first community radio station authorised to broadcast on mediumwave in France. It operated on 1593 kHz from Saint Gouéno with 10 kW but has been off-air since 22 November 2023 due to a problem with the power supply.

## Germany

Radio stations in Germany are licensed by media authorities in individual states, a result of Germany's federal structure. There are three nationwide public radio stations: Deutschlandfunk, broadcasting news and background stories on current affairs; Deutschlandfunk Kultur, mostly broadcasting cultural programmes; Deutschlandfunk Nova, a digital-only station which mainly broadcasts science and technology stories. Other public radio stations, run by local public broadcasters are generally only available in the states which those broadcasters operate.

### Low power mediumwave stations in Germany

There are a number of low-power mediumwave broadcasting stations in Germany that have started since the demise of regional, national and international broadcasting on long and mediumwave. Those stations currently believed to be on-air, either permanently or for special occasions, are:

#### Museumssender Cham

### GBC Enhances Radio Gibraltar with Fresh Programming.

www.gbc.gi/news/gbc-announces-new-and-stronger-tv-and-radio-schedule, which mentions that "The Radio Gibraltar Plus Smooth sound is extended from only evenings to daily from 2 pm as part of a commitment to offer further choice during the day. The variety of ballads and 'best from' music icons will play on 100.5 FM and 1458 MW with the choice also available online at gbc.gi and on the Radio Gibraltar App. There will also be a smoother sound across Sundays. Yesterday When I Was Young with Richard Cartwright stays on at 10am followed by a new Sunday show hosted by Radio Gibraltar veteran George Duboulay with a mix of ballads and classics offering a more relaxed listen. The Spanish language programme, traditionally at 2pm on weekdays moves to 7pm as a 1-hour show on the Plus service. Radio Gibraltar remains committed to its bilingual content and it's hoped a new carefully chosen time allows for greater accessibility and convenience for listeners of all ages". # Greece

## Ellinikí Radiofonía Tileóراسi (ERT)

The Hellenic Broadcasting Corporation (romanized: Ellinikí Radiofonía Tileóراسi A.E., lit. Greek Radio [and] Television S.A.), commonly shortened to ERT (Greek: EPT), is the state-owned public radio and television broadcaster of Greece.

## ERA-1

ERA-1 is the main programme of ERT. Transmitters broadcasting ERA-1 may also carry regional programmes at certain times of the day and relay the Kosmos programme in the evenings.

Kosmos 93.6 is the fourth public radio channel of Greece's public broadcaster, ERT, and is heard overnight on 1008 and 1305 kHz. The programme consists of world music, jazz, folk, reggae, Latin idioms, black music and Afro and adult European pop.

Ilida Radio 91.1 is a commercial radio station based in Amaliada, with a mediumwave transmitter in nearby Kastro-Kyllini.

# Hungary

## Magyar Rádió

Magyar Rádió is Hungary's publicly funded radio broadcasting organisation. It operates three services on mediumwave, Kossuth Rádió, Nemzetiségi Adások and Dankó Rádió.

## MR P1 - Kossuth Rádió

Kossuth Rádió is the First Programme of Magyar Radio, the national radio station of Hungary.

Wikipedia's Hungarian edition explains: "Kossuth Rádió's program on medium wave is not 24 hours. It can be heard on weekdays from 4:25 to 10:30 p.m. and on weekends from 4:55 to 10:30 p.m. Until the 2000s, it was available on medium wave until midnight, which was later cut back to 9 p.m., which was extended to 10:30 p.m. in the early 2010s. The measure can be partly explained by reasons of economy, partly by reasons of wave propagation. The Radio of the State of Kuwait (Sulaibiyah) 600 kW transmitter interfered with the reception of Kossuth Radio in the evening due to the peculiarities of wave propagation. On December 31, or on special, justified or extraordinary occasions, the broadcast will not stop at 10:30 p.m., but after midnight, or it can be heard 24 hours a day. On this frequency, the program (in variable quality) can be received practically during the day in the entire Carpathian basin ...".

Magyar Radio's P4 service, Nemzetiségi Adások, broadcasts in the languages of national minorities of Hungary.

Radio North has been broadcasting for over 20 years and has established the largest audience for its genre of music. Radio North is also the premier station for advertisers and is constantly attracting new customers daily due to its easy listening programming".

### Radio Lenta / Radio Pravda

Radio Lenta (and may also refer to itself as Radio Pravda) is a project that started broadcasting on 5 August 2022 on 1557 kHz from a transmitter in Lithuania. The programmes are produced in the Netherlands and intended for listeners in Russia, with the purpose of directing against disinformation, against war, and to compensate for Russian anti-Ukrainian propaganda. The transmitter has a rich history, being the one that was used by Big L on AM 1395 kHz from Trintelhaven in the Netherlands, in an attempt to reach a daytime audience in England. Later it was used on 1008 kHz to broadcast the religious station Groot Nieuws Radio. Since GNR's closure on 1008 kHz in early 2019, the transmitter had been stored in the Netherlands before being moved to Lithuania. It may also ID as "Nasha Lenta" ("Our Band") in Russian.

## **Pridnestrovian Moldavian Republic**

The self-proclaimed Pridnestrovian Moldavian Republic is an unrecognised state which controls part of the geographical region of Transnistria (the area between the Dniester river and Ukraine) and also the city of Bender and its surrounding localities on the west bank. This area was part of the former Moldavian SSR, and since the dissolution of the USSR has been claimed by the Republic of Moldova as the Administrative-Territorial Units of the Left Bank of the Dniester. The region is considered by the UN to be part of Moldova.

### **Pridnestrovsky Radioteletsentr - Maiac**

The Grigoriopol transmitter, officially the Transnistrian Radio and Television Center, is a very large broadcasting facility situated near Maiac, an urban settlement 11 km (7 miles) northeast of Grigoriopol, Transnistria (Moldova). At the end of the 1960s, the Soviet Union began building a powerful radio broadcasting station for propaganda to Western countries in Grigoriopol. Construction work on this facility, which included both mediumwave and shortwave transmitters, took place between 1968 and 1975. The de facto Transnistrian authorities sold the facility to the Russian state media company RIA Novosti in 2007.

### **Radio 1 Plyus**

Radio 1 Plyus is the Second Programme of the broadcasting service in PMR and is an information and music station for older people. The schedule consists of programmes produced by Radio 1 Plyus with news and information from Radio 1.

### Dutch low-power mediumwave stations

With the cessation of NPO Radio 5's broadcasts on 747 kHz and 1251 kHz in late 2015, the Dutch government opened a public consultation on opening up the medium waveband for low powered broadcasting. In May 2016, it was formally announced that 747, 828, 1035, 1251, and 1395 kHz (previously used by full-power stations) would have a maximum transmission power of 100 watts, while 1485 kHz would have a maximum transmission power of 1 watt. Other frequencies have since been added.

The current company dates from 2007, with the merger of two previously separate companies Radiodifusão Portuguesa (RDP; the radio broadcaster) and Radiotelevisão Portuguesa (television broadcaster), although they had been grouped under a single holding company and common branding since 2004.

## Antena 1

Antena 1 is one of the three national radio channels produced by RTP and has a general programming policy focusing mainly on news, current affairs and sport, as well as the discussion of contemporary social issues, with the musical accent on Portuguese popular music. Societatea Română de Radiodifuziune (SRR, the Romanian Broadcasting Society), informally referred to as Radio România, is an autonomous public broadcasting service of national interest, with attributions of information, education and entertainment, editorially independent, which carries out its activity under the control of Parliament, under the conditions of Law no. 41 of July 17, 1994 (republished and updated) and in accordance with the international conventions to which Romania is a party. SRR's two national stations on MW are Radio România Actualități and Antena Satelor.

## Radio România Actualități

Radio România Actualități (RRA; English: Radio Romania News) is a public radio station, providing information of national interest, which reflects daily events, both domestic and international. It focuses on the infotainment format, which combines music (from the last 4 decades) with news. Radio Romania Actualități is the only station in Romania with national coverage of over 99% of the country's territory.

## Sweden

### Sveriges Radio

SR is Sweden's national publicly funded radio broadcaster. Sveriges Radio is a public limited company, owned by an independent foundation, and funded through a licensing fee, the level of which is decided by the Swedish Riksdag. Four radio channels are available nationwide on FM and digital radio.

### SBH Hörby Radioförening

SBH Hörby Radioförening is a heritage radio station run by volunteers. It uses a 5 Watt transmitter on 1179 kHz which is located at Karlsfält, the place where Hörby's first mediumwave transmitter was located between 1928 and 1937. Karlsfält is approximately 5 km south of Hörby and close to where the later Hörby transmitting station was located from 1937-38 until its closure in 2010. Each year, a license is issued by the Swedish PTS for an event "Veteran Sound Day" with the latest operating between 27 August and 9 September 2023 (no event in 2024?)

### Asfalttelegraf

Asfalttelegraf is a Swedish rock radio station that operates on mediumwave under a temporary license. It was last on air between 23 December 2023 to 6 January 2024 on 1494 kHz from Ludvika with 1 kW.

## Switzerland

### Swiss Broadcasting Corporation

The Swiss Broadcasting Corporation (SRG SSR; German: Schweizerische Radio und Fernsehgesellschaft, French: Société Suisse de Radiodiffusion et Télévision, Italian: Società Svizzera di Radiotelevisione, Romansh: Societad Svizra da Radio e Televisiun) is the Swiss public broadcasting association. There is no broadcasting on LW or MW.

## Ukraine

### Ukrainian Radio

Ukrainian Radio is the publicly funded radio broadcaster in Ukraine. In 2017 it was merged with the national TV company into the country's public broadcaster, Suspilne. Until the creation of the National Public Broadcasting Company of Ukraine, the National Radio Company of Ukraine was an independent company. The Ukrainian Radio Directorate of the Suspilne is a structural subdivision of the company, which integrates five broadcasting channels, the studios of Radio House and the Recording House of Ukrainian Radio, and five radio ensembles.

On 1 September 2023, after an eight-month break, Ukrainian Radio's 1st Channel resumed broadcasting on 1278 kHz (Pokrovske, Odesa region). This means that RFE/RL's Krym.Realii programme is also back on MW (1138-1158 UTC on Saturdays, see below).

Ukrainian Radio on 1278 kHz had been off air since 20 May 2024, probably related to nationwide power outages in one way or another. It was, however, noted back on air on 20 June, although with rather low modulation. Broadcasts may be irregular due to further power outages. (reports from Alex Miatlikov, Ukraine)

Ukrainian MW transmitters on 657, 873, and 1404 kHz have been off air since 1 January 2023. According to the National Council of Television and Radio Broadcasting, Suspilne cancelled broadcasting on MW due to a lack of funding. In addition, the antenna system in Chasiv Yar (873 kHz) was damaged by shelling in December 2022.

### Krym.Realii

Krym.Realii is a regional news outlet of RFE/RL's Ukrainian Service that delivers radio, TV, and online news to people living in Crimea, the Ukrainian peninsula annexed by Russia in March 2014. Following the invasion of Ukraine by Russia, the existing transmitter of Krym.Realii on MW 648 kHz (Chonhar, Ukraine - 25 kW) went off air on 24 February 2022. However, on 1 September 2023, Ukrainian Radio's 1st Channel resumed broadcasting on 1278 kHz (Pokrovske, Odesa region) and this means that RFE/RL's Krym.Realii programme is also back on MW as part of its schedule. Earlier, this programme occasionally had some episodes in Russian, but now they use voice-over translation into Ukrainian when the interviewees speak in Russian. (Alex Miatlikov, Ukraine, 2 Sept. 2023)

Radio Ukraine International, abbreviated RUI, is the official international broadcasting station of Ukraine, with foreign language news and programming being produced in several languages by Ukrainian Radio's main editorial department (see below). The Ukrainian language programming aired on RUI is produced by the domestic First Channel. Radio Ukraine International provides listeners with up-to-date information in a format of short podcasts. Although there are currently no broadcasts on mediumwave from Ukraine itself, there is a relay over Radio Baltic Waves International in Lithuania on 1386 kHz:

Vatican Radio is the official broadcasting service of the Vatican. Vatican Radio no longer broadcast on mediumwave.

## British DX Club

The club was founded in 1974 as the Twickenham DX Club and celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2024. From local roots came rapid expansion to become one of the major radio clubs in the United Kingdom. The more appropriate title of British DX Club was adopted in 1979. We now have a large UK-based membership as well as a substantial number of overseas members.

"Communication" is BDXC's monthly publication, typically of around 60 pages. The club is proud of the quick turnaround of "Communication" which is normally sent to members within a week of the contribution deadline each month. It is available by post as a handy A5 booklet, or by e-mail as a pdf file. Regular sections include:

- Logbooks - loggings sent in by members: Medium Wave Logbook (medium and long wave bands), Tropical Logbook (below 5.8 MHz), HF Logbook (5.8 to 30 MHz), "Beyond the Horizon" (FM and TV bands)
- DX News & Medium Wave Report: Developments in international broadcasting, frequency and transmission schedules, the exciting world of clandestine radio, listening tips, etc.
- UK News: Comprehensive roundup of UK broadcasting covering BBC, commercial and community radio, RSLs, Low Power AM stations, DAB, etc.
- Open to Discussion: BDXC's Mailbox - a forum for members to express opinions on radio-related topics.
- QSL Report: Reception confirmations received by members, plus tips on obtaining those elusive ones.
- Webwatch: a regular survey of web sites of interest to radio enthusiasts.
- Alternative Airwaves: Station logs and news about the ever-changing free radio scene.
- Broadcasts in English: A complete frequency-by-frequency guide to international broadcasts in English, in time order, including transmitter sites. Sent to members twice a year, usually in May and December, to cover the summer and winter schedule periods. It also includes a Guide to DX/Media Programmes.
